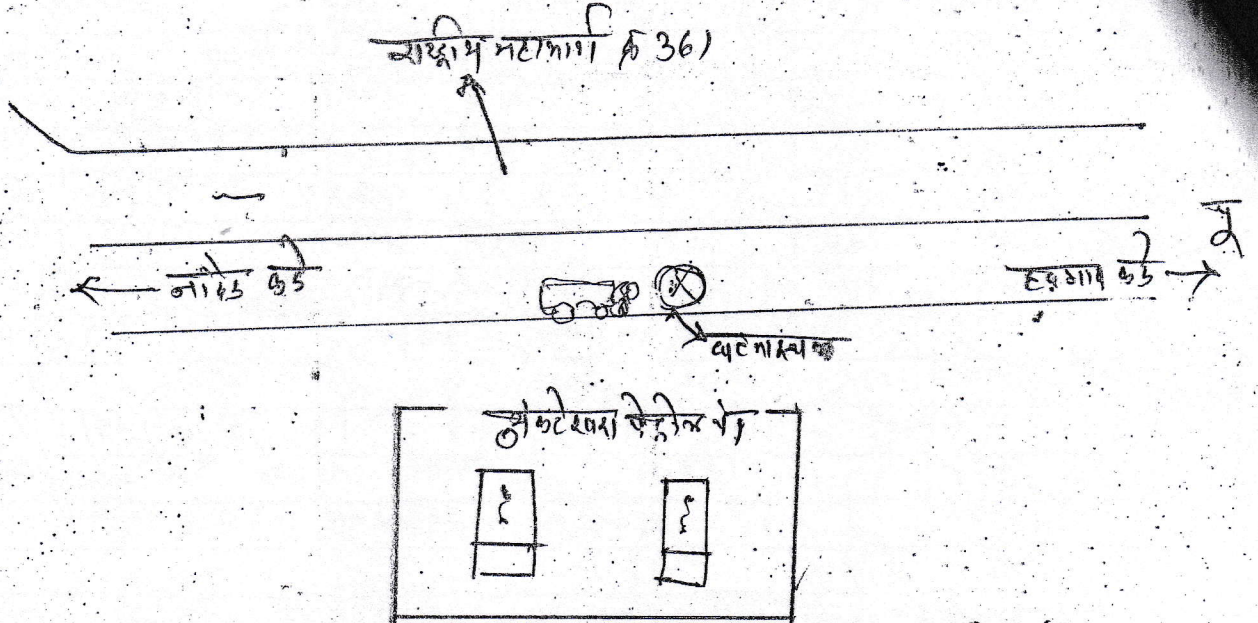

⑥ lacerated ~~or~~ sutured wound present on posterior aspect of right thigh, 6cm below iliac crest, obliquely placed, 4 suture present in situ, on opening of size 6cm x 1.5cm tissue deep.

⑦ Therapeutic intercostal drain wound present on left side of chest, between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> inter ribs, cavity deep of size 3cm x 1.5cm x cavity deep, on midaxillary line.

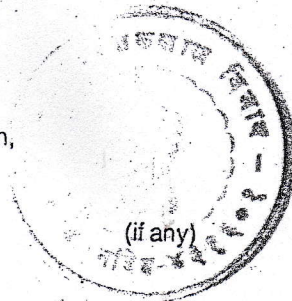
