

1] Stapled wound present over right fronto-parietal-temporal region, of 'C' shape, of size 31cm, with 48 black sutures present insitu.

2] Stapled wounds present over left frontal region of size 4cm with 5 black sutures present insitu.

3] Stapled wound present over left parietal region of size 4cm with 7 black sutures present insitu.

4] Therapeutic tracheostomy wound present over anterior aspect of neck, centrally placed, of size 1cm x 0.5 x tracheal cavity deep.

5] Abrasion present over dorsum of left hand of size 2cm x 1cm, fallen scab.

6] Abrasion present over right forearm, just below elbow over lateral aspect, of size 3cm x 2cm, fallen scab.

7] Healed sutured wound present over right side of abdomen, situated 6cm lateral to umbilicus, of 5 sutures present insitu. of length 7cm.

8] Abrasion present over right knee, of size 4cm x 3cm, fallen scab

9] Abrasion present 2cm medial to injury no. 8, on right knee, anterior aspect of size 2cm x 1.5cm, fallen scab.

10] Abrasion present over dorsum of right foot, of size 7cm x 3.5cm with scab present

III. Internal Examination—

19. Head—

(i) Injuries under the scalp. their nature.

Corresponding to injury no. ①, under scalp contusion present over right fronto-temporal-parietal region, brownish in colour.

(ii) **Skull**— Vault and base—describe fractures. their sites, dimensions, directions, etc.

Corresponding to injury no. ① in column ①7, piece of right fronto-parietal-temporal region, of size 12cm x 9.5cm, margins clean cut. Two burr holes of size of 1cm diameter present over left fronto-parietal region.

(iii) **Brain**—The appearance of its coverings, size, weight and general condition of the organ itself and any abnormality found in its examination to be carefully noted (weight M. 3 grams F. 2.75 grams).

Meninges clean cut, pale.
CSF turbid.

Brain oedematous, soft, pale.

Contusion necrosis present over left parietal region.


